ECMO for Cardiopulmonary Failure in Adults July, 2010 Portland Oregan

This is a course designed to help existing or proposed ECMO centers decide whether and how to expand or establish ECMO capability for adult patients. The broad principles are covered, including personnel, training, and equipment that are necessary to manage ECMO in adults. The course is intentionally tightly scheduled to accommodate busy schedules. Participants can arrive on the morning of Day 1 and depart on the afternoon of Day 2. The course material is the ELSO "Red Book" and the ELSO Management Guidelines. Pre course reading and case example home work is assigned. The course is designed for physicians. We are also working on a specialist training course and details will be coming soon. Registration fee is \$800 per person. Attendance is limited to 100 participants.
