Report from the Logistics and Education Committee

Educational Programs: In March, the fourth ELSO Adult VV ECMO course was held in San Antonio TX at the Wilford Hall Medical Center. Our previous courses have been hosted by The University of Michigan, Legacy Emanuel Hospital in Portland OR, and Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. The conferences have evolved into a 4 day course with 12 hours of didactic sessions and 20 hours of high fidelity simulation. Our next conference will be at the end of this year, back in Atlanta.

ECMO Specialist Certification: After general discussions at the Logistics and Education Sub-committee meetings in Florida and Keystone, and at a certification subcommittee meeting in Florida, a recommendation was made to the Steering Committee to engage a consulting firm specializing in certification. This was approved by the Steering Committee, and after interviewing multiple national firms, KNAPP Associates was selected. KNAPP has extensive experience with certification and has assisted many medical and nursing organizations develop their organization's certification program. www.knappinternational.com We will be having the first of two teleconferences in May. A multidisciplinary committee was selected from ELSO members who have been active in the Logistics and Education Committee and also those that have been participating in the The groups represented are: nursing, certification discussions. respiratory care, perfusion, physician, and the international community. The primary purpose of these initial meetings is to understand the steps required to develop a program and to develop a sample action plan to help guide the discussion and expose the challenges and missteps commonly encountered. A strategic session is also planned to identify the essential steps ELSO will need to consider before deciding whether to proceed with certification. An update will be presented at the

Scottsdale ELSO Logistics and Education Committee meeting in September.

ELSO Guidelines and Sample Exams: Some of the guidelines are due for the three year review. We are looking for volunteers to assist in the process. We are also collecting sample examinations used to "certify" ECMO specialists and physicians at ELSO institutions. The purpose for the exam collection is to identify the ECLS concepts that are universally being taught and tested. This will help us develop our educational programs in the future. 



Certification News

The results of the most recent certification survey were presented at the CNMC Symposium on ECMO & Advanced Therapies for Respiratory Failure in February 2011. Forty four ECMO centers responded to the survey posted on the ELSO Newsletter and ECLS-NET listsery. Each center was instructed to read the survey, collect individual responses from their ECMO Team, and respond to the survey one time only. This method was selected due to the difficulty reaching a large number of ECMO Team members individually using the newsletter and ECLS-NET. If a center responded to the survey more than once, the data from the second response was not used.


