Summary:

The Extracorporeal Life Support Organization (ELSO) is an international non-profit consortium of health care institutions dedicated to the development and evaluation of novel therapies for support of failing organ systems.

ELSO hosts the world's oldest and largest ECMO (Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation) patient registry, with over 160,000 patient cases in the registry, and growing. ELSO Registry data is used for multiple purposes, including research, teaching, and device performance – all in an effort to continue to improve patient outcomes for those treated with ECMO-related technology.

The Data Visualization Specialist will use data and be able to create compelling data visualization for our members in a variety of platforms. We are interested in a specialist that can work with data across web platforms and create data formats that can be personalized by members. We work with health data, technology, and other data. It is foundational to our organization. The ability to share complex data in visual and engaging formats will increasingly be of value to ELSO and its members.
